Covered Preventive Services for Adults

- Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm one-time screening for men of specified ages who have ever smoked
- · Alcohol Misuse screening & counseling
- Aspirin use to prevent cardiovascular disease for men & women of certain ages
- · Blood Pressure screening for all adults
- · Cholesterol screening for adults of certain ages or at higher risk
- · Colorectal Cancer screening for adults over 50
- · Depression screening for adults
- Diabetes (Type 2) screening for adults with high blood pressure
- · Diet counseling for adults at higher risk for chronic disease
- · Hepatitis B screening for all adults at higher risk
- Hepatitis C screening for adults at increased risk, & one time for everyone born 1945 - 1965

- · HIV screening for everyone ages 15 to 65 & other ages at increased risk
- Immunization vaccines for adults doses, recommended ages, and recommended populations vary: Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Herpes Zoster, Human Papillomavirus, Influenza (Flu Shot), Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Meningococcal, Pneumococcal, Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Varicella
- Lung Cancer Screening for adults 55-80 because they're heavy smokers or have quit in the past 15 years
- · Obesity screening & counseling for all adults
- Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) prevention counseling for adults at higher risk
- · Syphilis screening for all adults at higher risk
- Tobacco Use screening for all adults & cessation interventions for tobacco users



Covered Preventive Services for Women

- · Anemia screening on a routine basis for pregnant women
- Breast Cancer Genetic Test Counseling (BRCA) for women at higher risk for breast cancer
- Breast Cancer Mammography screenings every 1 to 2 years for women over 40
- · Breast Cancer Chemoprevention counseling for women at higher risk
- Breast feeding comprehensive support & counseling from trained providers, and access to breast feeding supplies, for pregnant & nursing women
- · Cervical Cancer screening for sexually active women
- Chlamydia Infection screening for younger women & other women at higher risk
- Contraception: Food & Drug Administration-approved contraceptive methods, sterilization procedures, and patient education & counseling, as prescribed by a health care provider for women with reproductive capacity (not including abortifacient drugs); this does not apply to health plans sponsored by certain exempt "religious employers"
- · Domestic & interpersonal violence screening & counseling for all women
- · Folic Acid supplements for women who may become pregnant

- Gestational diabetes screening for women 24 to 28 weeks pregnant & those at high risk of developing gestational diabetes
- · Gonorrhea screening for pregnant women
- · Gonorrhea screening for women at increased risk
- Hepatitis B screening for pregnant women at their first prenatal visit
- · HIV screening & counseling for sexually active women
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV) DNA Test every 3 years for women with normal cytology results who are 30 or older
- · Osteoporosis screening for women over age 60 depending on risk factors
- Rh Incompatibility screening for pregnant women
- Rh Incompatibility screening follow up testing for women at higher risk
- Sexually Transmitted Infections counseling for sexually active women
- · Syphilis screening for pregnant women
- · Syphilis screening for women at increased risk
- Tobacco Use screening & intervention (expanded) for pregnant women
- Tobacco Use screening & intervention for all women
- Urinary tract or other infection screening for pregnant women
- · Well-woman visits to get recommended services for women under 65

- · Cervical Dysplasia screening for sexually active females
- · Depression screening for adolescents
- · Developmental screening for children under age 3
- Dyslipidemia screening for children at higher risk of lipid disorders at the following ages: 1 to 4 years, 5 to 10 years, 11 to 14 years, 15 to 17 years
- Fluoride Chemoprevention supplements for children without fluoride in their water source
- Gonorrhea preventive medication for the eyes of all newborns
- Hearing screening for all newborns
- Height, Weight and Body Mass Index measurements for children at the following ages: 0 to 11 months, 1 to 4 years, 5 to 10 years, 11 to 14 years, 15 to 17 years
- · Hematocrit or Hemoglobin screening for children

Through our proprietary Private Physician Network (PPN)™ across the nation, Healthcare 2U is breaking down the barriers to convenient access to quality primary care with a focus on promoting healthy living while preventing disease. Members receive the unlimited services listed below by scheduling care through Healthcare 2U's Central Scheduling Department (CSD) during business hours.

Unlimited Direct Primary Care*

- Unlimited doctor visits with a \$10 visit fee
- Unlimited urgent care visits with a \$25 visit fee
- Annual physical¹ with four labs: complete metabolic panel (CMP), complete blood count (CBC), thyroid stimulating hormone (TSH) and lipid panel
- Patient navigation center staffed by bilingual medical assistants to schedule care for members and eligible participants

Unlimited Virtual DPC²

• Unlimited access to bilingual licensed medical providers online or by phone, 24/7/365 for minor illnesses and injuries at \$0 out of pocket cost to members

Unlimited Chronic Disease Management*

- Unlimited treatment and management of 13 chronic disease states for the same \$10 visit fee. Healthcare2U accepts pre-existing conditions within manageable ranges, including:

- No walk-ins allowed. Unlimited services (including Virtual DPC/telehealth) must be accessed through Healthcare2U's Central Scheduling Department (CSD). In-office appointments are only available within business hours (Monday through Friday, 7 AM to 6 PM CST). The CSD may direct the member to another level of care if appropriate, depending on the member's condition and utilization of services.
- Well-woman pap smear pathology interpretation is not included. Dependent on membership, there may be a waiting period (six consecutive months of membership) before the member is granted eligibility for the annual physical.
- Telehealth services are provided through MeMD, a third-party provider. When medically necessary, MeMD's providers can submit a prescription electronically for purchase and pick-up at your local participating pharmacy; however, MeMD providers cannot prescribe elective medications, narcotic pain relievers, or controlled substances. MeMD's providers are each licensed by the appropriate licensing board for the state in which they are providing services, and all have prescriptive authority for each of the states in which they are licensed. MeMD provides access to online medical consultations with physicians, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants who can write prescriptions when medically necessary and permitted by state law. MeMD is not an online pharmacy, and medications cannot be purchased or dispensed from MeMD directly. MeMD is not a replacement for your primary care physician or annual doctor's office visit. Subject to state regulations, MeMD is available nationwide with providers licensed to practice in your state who use video and/or audio
- Healthcare 2U's Direct Primary Care is a healthcare membership. It is not insurance.
- The discount program is provided through a third-party provider.



The Health Wallet app is where you will find details on your Health plan benefits and where you will access your ID cards.


- Go to the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.
